According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia, the hospitality sector is a critical contributor to Malaysia's GDP, accounting for approximately 15% of employment in 2023. This sector, covering hotels, food and beverage services, and tourism, is anticipated to grow at an annual rate of 6% through 2026, spurred by increasing tourism and government initiatives like Visit Malaysia campaigns. According to Tourism Malaysia, tourist arrivals rebounded strongly post-pandemic, with over 10 million visitors recorded in 2023, marking a 70% increase from the previous year. iv. A pass in SKM level 3 in a related field;

OR

v. A Certificate (Level 3, MQF) in a related field or its equivalent.
